

- Industry club membership dues do <u>not</u> cover travel expenses for out-of-state tournament events.
- Industry's National Championship Travel Teams will attend two out-of-state competitions, a
  Junior Olympic Qualifier or AAU equivalent, and the AAU National Championships, with
  travel dates to be determined.
- Players and parent(s)/guardian(s) understand that travel to these out-of-state competitions is contingent upon securing two parent/guardian chaperones of rostered players. Players and parent(s)/guardian(s) understand that travel events can be cancelled if two parent chaperones are not secured.
- It is an unfair burden to both the team and Industry for any committed travel team player to not travel or pay her proportional share of travel costs. Therefore, all travel team players are required to pay their full travel dues regardless of their ability to travel or complete the season for any reason.
- Each rostered player is responsible for her proportional share of the financial burden incurred by the team for all travel events and, thus, Industry shall calculate all event costs based on the full team roster.
- Estimate out-of-state travel costs are \$2800 for the 2019-2020 season can can be paid in full, quarterly or monthly installments.
- If costs exceed this \$2800 estimate, each rostered player shall pay her proportionate share of the additional fees.
- If costs incurred are less than the \$2800 estimate, Industry shall apply each player's overpayment to that player's outstanding club membership dues, if any.
- Any National Championship Travel Team player who is not current on her club membership dues payment or travel payment may forfeit her spot on the team's roster.

### SCVA Letter of Commitment - Junior Girls

(Non San Diego Members)

DO NOT SIGN WITHOUT READING CAREFULLY. DO NOT SIGN PRIOR TO AUGUST 6, 2019 (15-18&UNDER AND ALL HIGH SCHOOL AGED PLAYERS) OR OCTOBER 8, 2019 (14&UNDER).

This requirement has been created to protect the player and parent/guardian as a member of a club.

- 1. Basic Penalty. I understand that by signing this letter. I am committed to joining the club named with this document for the entire 2019/2020 season. If I compete for another club, I may be subject to suspension for the remainder of the season.
  - a. Early Signing Period. A player who signs a Letter of Commitment before August 6, 2019 (15-18&under AND ALL HIGH SCHOOL AGED PLAYERS) or October 8, 2019 (14&under) is subject to suspension for the entire season. A club representative may not ask a player to sign prior to August 6, 2019 (15-18&under AND ALL HIGH SCHOOL AGED PLAYERS) or October 8, 2019 (14&under) either.
  - b. A player may not sign a Letter of Commitment before August 6, 2019(15-18&under AND ALL HIGH SCHOOL AGED PLAYERS) or October 8, 2019 (14&under) regardless of the date of the tryout. A player who signs a Letter of Commitment or a club that allows a player to sign at a tryout date prior to August 6<sup>th</sup> (15-18&under) or October 8<sup>th</sup> (14&under) is subject to suspension for the entire season. Under no conditions may the Letter of Commitment be pre-signed or pre-dated before this time frame. In turn, no deposit monles, team or club fees can be collected before August 6, 2019 (15-18&under) or October 8, 2019 (14&under).
  - c. Only One Letter of Commitment Permitted. A player who signs more than one Letter of Commitment with more than one club is subject to suspension for the entire 2019/2020 season.
- Verbal Commitments. A player may commit verbally to a club prior to August 6, 2019 (15-18&under AND ALL HIGH SCHOOL AGED PLAYERS) or October 8, 2019 (14&under). A verbal commitment is not binding. The player may revoke the commitment at any time, before signing the Letter of Commitment, without penalty.
- 3. Recruiting Ban after Signing. I understand that all clubs are obligated to respect my signing and shall cease to recruit me upon my signing this document. I shall notify any recruiter who contacts me that I have signed.
- 4. Club Signatures Required Prior to Submission to the SCVA. This document must be signed and dated by the Club Director before being submitted to the SCVA along with other registration documents.
- 5. Parent/Guardian Signature Required. My parent, or legal guardian, is required to sign this Letter of Commitment if I am less than 21 years of age at the time of signing.
- 6. Falsification of Letter of Commitment. If I falsify any part of this Letter of Commitment, including the date, I understand that I am subject to suspension for the entire 2019/2020 season.
- Nullification of Other Agreements. My signature on this Letter of Commitment nullifles any agreements, verbal or otherwise, which
  would release me from the conditions stated within this document.
- 8. Binding Agreement. I understand that I have signed this Letter of Commitment with the club and not with a particular individual. If the coach or any player(s) leave the team, I remain bound by the provisions of this document for the entire 2019/2020 season. I certify that I have read all terms and conditions in this document. I have discussed them with the club representative named within, and I fully understand, accept, and agree to be bound by them.

- Violation of any anti-doping policies, protocols or procedures as defined by the International Olympic Committee (IOC; www.ohmpic.cog), World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA; www.wada-ama.org), Federation Internationale de Volleyball (FIVB; www.fixb.org), US Anti-Doping Agency (USADA; www.usada.org) or the United States Olympic Committee (USOC; www.feamusa.org). Violations of this provision will be adjudicated only by USADA or the proper anti-doping authority, not USA Volleyball (USAV).
- Violation of safe sport rules, policies and procedures promulgated by the U.S. Center for SafeSport (www.safesport.org), as they may be amended from time to time.
- Possession, consumption or distribution of alcohol and/or tobacco if flegal or in violation of USAV or Regional Volleyball Association (RVA) policy. 3.

#### IndustryVBC Parent contract & commitment of support:

- Parents shall never discuss any playing time issues at tournaments, ever. Thus, parents shall refrain from distracting coaches and/or players during competition and practice.
- Player to coach interaction is the first outlet for any player concerns, not parent coach interaction. Should parent coach interaction become necessary it must be through prearranged times and dates to discuss concerns.
- Parents will refrain from distracting coaches and/or players during competition and practice.
- Parents acknowledge that for a successful team effort, only one person can be in charge, and for this team that person is the coach.
- Parents acknowledge that the team coach is the primary contact in regards to training, practices and matches and that player coach communication is mandatory.
- All parents will respect all coach's decisions.
- Parents agree to abide by all contracts, rules and guidelines outlined in any and all Elite contracts and/or paperwork.
- Parents acknowledge that the commitment to the club is also a financial commitment and regardless of whether or not their athlete can or does finish the competition season under any circumstances, they assume responsibility for completing all payments, and completing them in a timely manner.
- Any difference of opinion that a parent may have with the coach will be discussed with the coach in a civil manner and at a time and place NOT in the presence of any team members.
- Anything that cannot be resolved to the mutual satisfaction of the coach and parent will then be addressed to the Club Director, again, NOT in the presence of team members or other persons, and at a time mutually convenient.
- Any discussion about team or players will include only my child, his/her abilities and what he/she needs to do to achieve
  what Industry is looking for from the team and club.
- I will make every effort to see that my child abides by the pledge she signed.
- This includes providing written / email notice in a timely manner, if my child cannot attend a practice or a tournament due to extenuating circumstances.
- I will be supportive of my child's full participation with the Elite/Industry VBC including but not limited to attending all practices and tournaments, speaking only positively about coaches, players and program in regards to ours and others, healthy eating and sleeping habits, and following all club training guidelines and directives both inside they gym and out.
- I will enthusiastically support the whole team and show good sportsmanship toward all members of this team and all members of opposing teams, at all times and under all circumstances.
- I recognize and accept that I am the adult, and that I set the tone for this behavior.

#### IndustryVBC PLAYER CONTRACT

#### Practice / Tournament Rules:

- Players are expected to attend every practice.
- Players acknowledge that while we operate in age groups we sometimes move players to teams which best suit the players ability and our club program.
- All players must remain at any practice, competition or tournament site until they receive permission from their coach to leave.
- Players are required to be at the gym at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled practice time.
- Players must be completely prepared both mentally and physically (shoes, kneepads etc.) to begin practice at the scheduled start time.
- If a player must miss a practice an email at least 24 hours in advance to their Head Coach and the Club Director, is required.
- If a player must miss a practice unexpectedly, a phone call must be made to their Head Coach prior to the practice.
- A written / email notice is mandatory if a player cannot make a practice or tournament due to extenuating circumstances; this notice should be sent to their Head Coach and the Club Director.
- If a player misses a practice that is unexcused then they may have to sit out 1 practice. Missing the practice before a tournament could potentially sit you out of at least the first match on tournament day.
- All club and facility equipment must be properly cared for and accounted for.
- All players are required to participate in all physical conditioning activities and drills unless excused by a doctor or the coach.
- All players are expected to fulfill all outside training assignments.
- Players understand that their commitment to their team and club is a commitment for the entire club season regardless of any extenuating circumstances.

#### **Players Standard of Conduct:**

- Coaches' decisions regarding conduct, meetings, meals, and schedules are final, both at practice and for games and tournaments.
- A serious difference of opinion may only be addressed at a later time, by contacting the Club Director.
- A player must report all physical injuries or any illness to the coach.
- No derogatory or negative comments about players, coaches or clubs.
- All players 15 and older must maintain a minimum level of fitness, which will be determined by hydrostatic weighing and body weight. If body fat percentage increases by more than 2% or body weight increases by more than 8% this will be deemed non compliant and could result in suspension. Players are expected to maintain a healthy lifestyle.
- Players shall not consume any alcohol, tobacco, or drugs.
- Players must notify and receive approval from coaches or the Club director for use of any non-prescription and/or prescription drugs.
- Players shall maintain healthy eating and sleeping practices as part of a daily routine.
- Players must be on time for all team commitments.
- Players are expected to attend every tournament.
- All players will abide by the rules established for scrimmage and tournament facilities, both locally and in other cities.
- Only good sportsmanship conduct toward fellow players and toward opposing team players will be tolerated.

I release all rights to any media taken before, during or after tryouts, clinics, practices or training including but not limited to photos and video understanding that it may be used for promotional or training purposes.

I understand, accept and will abide by these goals, rules, and standards of conduct. I understand that all player/coach, parent/coach and player/parent/coach meetings including team meetings may be recorded for training purposes. I also understand that any non-compliance can be cause for my playing status release from Industry and that being suspended or released from playing status does not alter my financial obligation.
